

RECORD VIDEOS FOR EACH SLIDE DECK

- · Rehearse, practice, and practice again avoid um's, ah's, and excessive pauses
- · Look and talk directly into the video camera act like this is a conversation with a friend or a one-to-one training
- · Share personal examples and stories of using the content, intervention, or strategy to connect with the audience and enhance your credibility
- · Record several short (10-15 min.) videos covering one objective/activity at a time

CONVERT PAPER HANDOUTS/ARTIFACTS TO DIGITAL AND UPLOAD FILES

- Create note-taking guide or handouts with key concepts
- Facilitator guides, training schedules, answer keys, virtual/physical set up guide
