Use this data sheet to record discrete or continuous behaviors. Record the number of times or length of time that the event occurs. Observe interval, duration, or latency of the behavior.

**Instructions:**

1. Record name, date, behavior, recording method, and criterion for mastery.

3. Whole Interval - record interval length in first column. √ if behavior occurs for *entire* interval.
4. Duration – record length of time a continuous behavior lasts during each opportunity or trial.
5. Latency – record the length of time between a teacher prompt and a students response during each trial.
